# Autumn One in Kite Class



## Literacy

The children will:

- enjoy a wide range of stories, rhymes and poems.
- Explore mark making and practise forming recognisable letters
- Practise writing their name.

### Little Wandle Letters and Sounds

In our daily phonics sessions the children will cover the following:

sounds: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, l,

Tricky words: I, is, the,

### Reading:

Children read three times a week in class in small groups.

Each session has a clear focus:

Read 1: decoding

Read 2: prosody – reading with meaning, stress and intonation

Read 3 comprehension – understanding the text.



## Maths

We will be learning to:

### **Match, sort and compare**

- Match pictures and objects
- identify a set, and sort objects to a type
- Explore sorting techniques.
- Create sorting rules and compare amounts.
- Find, subitise and represent and compose numbers to 3

### **Talk about measure and pattern**

- Compare size, mass and capacity
- Explore, copy, continue and create simple patterns
- Identify and compare circles and triangles

## Understanding the World

- What makes me unique
- Explore features of their immediate environment
- Observe seasonal changes (Autumn)
- Celebrate Harvest festival.
- Talk about their own past and present experiences
- Name parts of the body
- Sequence stages of human growth and change
- Identify people who help us

### **Creating with materials**

- Self-portraits
- Drawing, making models of the human form
- Exploring a wide range of media and materials

### **Being imaginative and expressive**

- Learn and sing songs and rhymes
- Explore, using instruments
- Engage actively in imaginative and small world play

## Communication and Language

- Communication and language will be promoted in all areas of learning
- Be confident initiating back and forth exchanges with adults and peers
- Ask and answer questions
- Enjoy a wide range of fiction and non fiction texts
- Learn new vocabulary and use this during imaginative play
- Listen to and follow instructions
- Express ideas and opinions confidently and talk about their play and learning.

## Personal and Social

- Build positive relationships with the adults and peers in school
- Become familiar with class routines
- Talk about what it means to be unique
- Recognise similarities and differences.
- Explore feelings and emotions
- Become familiar with class routines
- Listen to and follow simple instructions
- Listen to others and take turns to speak.

## Physical Development



- Be active and throughout the day
- Participate in two weekly PE sessions - Our PE days are: Monday and Friday
- Develop fine motor skills in activities such as bead threading, dough gym, drawing, tracing and mark making.
