Literacy

The children will:

- enjoy a wide range of stories, rhymes and poems.
- Explore mark making and practise forming recognisable letters
- Practise writing their name.

Little Wandle Letters and Sounds

In our daily phonics sessions the children will cover the following:
sounds: f l ss j v w x y z zz ch sh th ng nk

Tricky words: put, pull, full, as and, her, has, his, she, push, he, of, me, be, we

Reading:

Children read three times a week in class in small groups.

Each session has a clear focus:

Read 1: decoding

Read 2: prosody – reading with meaning, stress and intonation

Read 3 comprehension – understanding the text.

We will be learning to:

- Find 4 and 5
- Subitise 4 and 5
- Represent 4 & 5
- 1 more, 1 less
- Composition of 1 to 5

- Identify shapes with 4 sides
- Combine shapes with 4 sides

Creating with materials

- Firework painting
- Printing - vegetables/leaves

Being imaginative and expressive

- Perform in the Nativity play
- Learn and sing Nativity songs
- Engage actively in imaginative and small world play

Communication and Language

Communication and language will be promoted in all areas of learning:

- Participate in back and forth exchanges with adults and peers
- Ask and answer questions
- Share ideas and thoughts
- Listen to and discuss stories and non-fiction texts
- Learn new vocabulary and use this during imaginative play
- Listen to and follow instructions
- Express ideas and opinions confidently and talk about their play and learning.

Personal and Social

- Learn how to keep healthy, including, teeth brushing, hand washing and exercise.
- Celebrate similarities and differences.
- Explore and discuss feelings and emotions
- Listen to and follow instructions
- Listen to others and take turns to speak.

Physical Development

- Be active and throughout the day
- Participate in two weekly PE sessions - Our PE days are: Monday and Friday
- Develop fine motor skills in activities such as bead threading, dough gym, drawing, tracing and mark making
- Develop gross motor skills in activities such as, climbing, balancing, jumping and throwing
